City Librarian's Report

- 1. The new Adult Librarian, Brian Boies, started this week. It's great to have that position filled.
- 2. Why the Rocks, a poetry book launch inspired by the High Sierra Workshop, will occur March 11, on Zoom, courtesy of the Library.

Old Business

- 1. The Annual Presentation to the City Council on March 15, is in preparation. All the virtual ways we serve the community as an adaption to COVID-19 will be presented.
- 2. Progress on One-Year Plan
 - A. The focus this month has been on One City Read. There are 170 participants and 5-6 Book Clubs wanting a librarian to lead a discussion.
 - B. The Library was awarded a \$4,700 California Humanities Grant to teach teens to do oral histories with their families.
 - C. Plans are being done to place in a month free Wi-Fi at the Depot Plaza. Funds are from the Foundation Block Grant and the Friends. This service works to lessen the digital divide and relates to the equity goal.

D. The Friends also approved funding to have the hearing impaired have T-Coil Loop technology in the main Creekside rooms. New sound speakers will also add greater accessibility for older populations.
